Volunteer of *Distinction*

The Appraisal Institute's member recognition program honors members for their volunteer service to the Appraisal Institute, to the real estate valuation profession and to their local communities. Each month, the Appraisal Institute will recognize one honoree in each region.

WHO'S ELIGIBLE?

Any member in good standing who makes contributions to the Appraisal Institute, the appraisal profession or their local community is eligible to be recognized.

HOW ARE NOMINATIONS MADE?

Chapter executive directors will submit nominations, on a form provided on the Appraisal Institute's Web site, to their regional executive director. Any member may make suggestions to chapter executive directors (or chapter presidents).

WHO MAKES THE SELECTIONS?

Regional executive directors, in consultation as necessary with their regional chair and/or vice chair, will select honorees each month for their regions.

WHAT ARE THE CRITERIA?

Honorees will be selected based upon their volunteer service to the Appraisal Institute, to the real estate valuation profession and to their local community.

WHAT DO HONOREES RECEIVE?

Monthly honorees for each region will receive a certificate suitable for framing. The honored member's chapter also will receive a certificate.

HOW ELSE ARE HONOREES RECOGNIZED?

The Appraisal Institute's Web site will list each month's honorees. Additionally, honorees will be highlighted in Appraisal Institute emails to all members, such as Chapter FYI, the monthly President's Message and/or Appraiser News Online. And the Appraisal Institute will send a news release announcing the member's recognition to media outlets in the honoree's community. Chapters may also choose to recognize honored members of the chapter (e.g., a newsletter article or a presentation at a chapter meeting).
